

Second Hand Goods Information Sheet

Donating or on Consignment

- Second hand items can be donated to the school or sold on consignment.
- The school retains 25% of the sales of goods on consignment.
- All monies raised by donations or consignment sales goes back to the school.

Pricing Structure

- The school cannot sell 2nd hand items for greater than 50% of the listed new price.
- The selling price is set by the Finance Office, unless otherwise agreed.
- Prices start at 50% off for items in excellent, near new condition and are then marked down further according to the condition of the item.
- Money for consignment goods is calculated and paid at the end of each term into school accounts.
 - Sellers are provided with a summary of goods sold.

What can you sell?

- Any current school uniform items with the new logo.
- Non-school issue items such as culottes, cargo shorts, tracksuit pants, may be accepted if
 in very good condition, but these items are less likely to be purchased.

What can't you sell?

- Clothing in poor condition (i.e. with repairs, holes or stains)
- Non-school issue items such as royal blue Target t-shirts without a logo, navy or sky blue skivvies etc. will not be accepted.
- We no longer accept the old logo uniform. This can be sold via social media platforms or donated.
